Artists are encouraged to bring examples of their work to display and sell during their residency. The Raymer Society receives 25% of all sales during the artists stay. Kansas sales tax is charged on all sales.

Artists are also encouraged to give workshops in their area of expertise or interest. Proposals for the workshops should be made at the time of application. The Society receives 25% of the proceeds from the workshops.
